Only the leeboards and the rudder are gradually due for a new paint job. A new boiler has been installed in 2020. The mast can be lowered very easily by 1 person, creating an air draft of approximately 2,00 meters, according to the seller even slightly lower. In total there are 4 berths, 2 in the salon and 2 berths in the forecastle. Following up to the forecastle are the toilet, salon, galley and cockpit. In 2006 a new diesel engine was installed with currently only about 500 running hours on the hour counter. The sailingtjalk is available immediately.
