The engine room was completely emptied, then sandblasted and conserved. The engine, a 120 Hp Industrie, and the gearbox were almost completely overhauled by a specialist of Industrie engines. The fuel tanks have been replaced and a waste water tank has been installed. The toilet, galley and seating area are in front. In the rear cabin are 3 berths and a wash basin. The ship is in a very good condition.
