

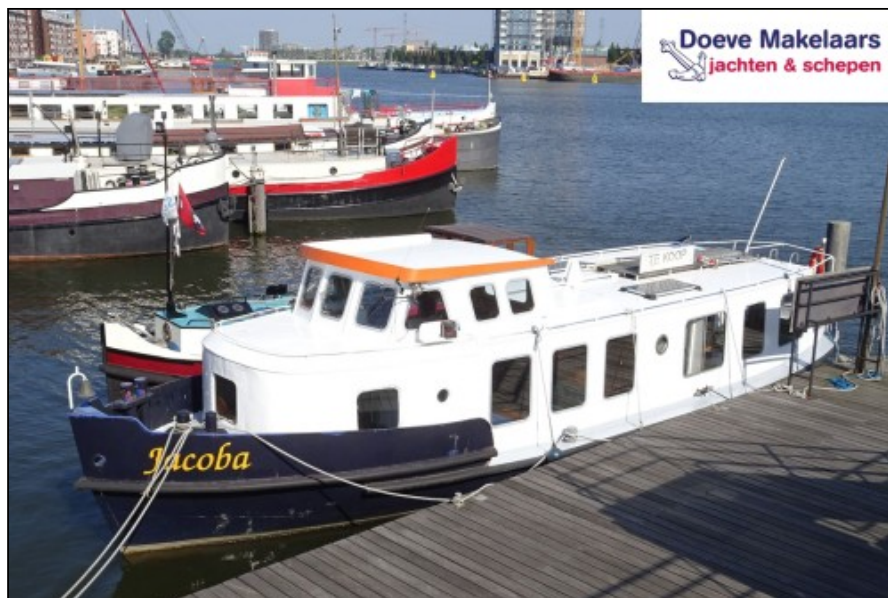

The interior is nautical with in the front still the old benches which can be converted into a 2 persons bed, wheelhouse with seating and a raised steering position and in the aft there are the toilet / bathroom (under construction), galley and seating area.
