A ship that has been insulated well so people can stay on board for a longer time or even live on her. The vessel is self-supporting by, among other things, the whisper generator. With the folding wheelhouse, the air draft is very low, which means that the ship can navigate on the Canal du Nivernais and the Canal du Midi. But she is also very suitable for the rest of the European waterways.
