This Luxury Motor is recognized as a Historic Vessel and is still propelled by her original engine. The forecastle is a small cabin with 1 berth. The cargo hold has a length of approximately 12.40 x 4.40 m. The self-loading and unloading gear is currently not available for using. Therefor are spare parts available for repair work. From the wheelhouse you enter the aft cabin. This was rebuilt a few years ago, but the old character was retained. This concerns a sitting area, countertop, toilet and a double bed. Very conveniently located mooring just 2 minutes from the train station and approximately 5 minutes from the highway. The city center is also close by and within walking distance. The ship is extremely suitable for rebuild completely to your own wishes as a houseboat or studio. At the beginning of 2024, the vessel was fitted with a largely new bottom and the bilges were doubled where necessary. In total, the seller has invested more than 50.000 euros in the vessel, making her ready for a new future.
