Finely, this beautifully shaped Tjalk was converted into a recreational vessel in 1960, a deckhouse was installed then with an open cockpit behind it, but she was also shortened to her current length. There are 2 double beds and 1 single bed on board and it is also possible to sleep on the sofa. The spacious salon is ship-style and together with the open, traditional-looking galley it is an attractive salon.
