Powered by a Volvo Penta main engine and fitted with a proportional bow thruster, this Luxe Motor offers excellent maneuverability. The interior is suitable for permanent residence, with, among other things, two cabins, two bathrooms, a spacious salon with open galley, a washing machine and even a bathtub. The functional interior finish includes, among other things, an oak floor and various heating systems (diesel stoves, wood stove, infrared panels). Sufficient headroom is available throughout. A beautifully lined live aboard cruising vessel, combining charm, comfort and certification – ideal for water enthusiasts who wants to both navigation and habitation.
