The French doors between the cockpit and the salon create an open living space in which outside and inside merge seamlessly. From the salon you have a good view of the surroundings all around. Ideal for the skipper while sailing but also gives more experience for the passengers. The galley is equipped with a geyser and a 2-burner gas hob.
