

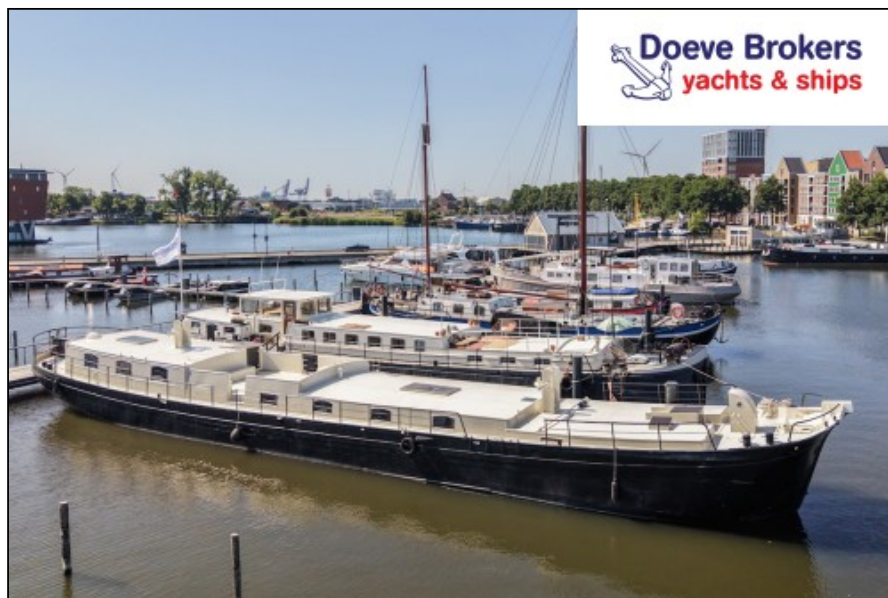

This magnificent Clipper hull, measuring no less than 34.50 meters in length, offers approx. 147 m² of living space and 176 m² of deck area, providing an exceptional foundation for the creation of a luxurious and comfortable residence on the water. The vessel was lengthened in NL-Zwartsluis, after which she underwent an extensive refurbishment of the hull at SRF Shipyard in NL-Harlingen. There, the hull was hydro-jet blasted and treated with a high-quality protective coating system, resulting in a strong, durable and well-preserved foundation for the completion of the fit-out. The renowned Dutch naval architect Olivier van Meer has developed a concept for the future interior, envisioning an elegant and comfortable living environment where spaciousness, natural light and premium residential quality are central elements. Artist's impressions of his design are included in the photo gallery. With her generous dimensions, classic Clipper lines and excellent hull condition, this vessel offers numerous possibilities, ranging from an exclusive liveaboard sailing vessel to a unique combination of residential, business and recreational use on the water. As an additional opportunity, the current residential berth may also be available to take over. This offers the rare possibility of combining this unique vessel with a permanent waterside residence. A unique opportunity for those seeking space, character

and a future-proof lifestyle afloat. A DAF 1160 engine is eventually also available.
